On 20th March 2025, a significant milestone was achieved at GHPS Hagaribommanahalli, Vijayanagara District, Karnataka, with the inauguration of enhanced school infrastructure under the Jagmag Pathshala initiative, supported by Signify India. The event, conducted in a hybrid mode to include both in-person and online participants, reflected the growing role of digital connectivity in modern education.



Representing Signify India, Rakesh Kumar Singh, Lead CSR, joined representatives from eVidyaloka, including Brinda, Akshay, Aditi, Shruthi, Deepika, Vinay, Santosh, and Madhusudhan, along with partner NGO RISE. 

International Women's Day - Fireside Chat with Netra Ganapathy



On the occasion of International Women's Day 2025, eVidyaloka hosted an inspiring fireside chat featuring Nethra Ganapathy, Senior Strategist at Microsoft India, in conversation with Brinda Poornapragna, CEO of eVidyaloka.



Nethra shared powerful insights drawn from her own journey, emphasizing the importance of creating spaces where women feel empowered to voice their opinions, make choices, and grow with the support of strong mentorship. She highlighted how mentorship and building robust networks have been pivotal to her career growth, encouraging women to support each other along the way.

The conversation touched upon the unique strengths women bring to leadership roles, such as empathy and persistence, and how these traits contribute to long-term success. Nethra also spoke about the value of continuous learning, staying updated with industry trends, and leveraging technology – particularly Artificial Intelligence – to drive social impact and make education more accessible.

Addressing the challenges of work-life balance, she shared practical strategies for managing personal and professional responsibilities, and advocated for breaking barriers that limit women's leadership opportunities. To young women entering the workforce, her advice was clear: embrace your journey, believe in yourself, build strong support networks, and lead with empathy and integrity.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where employees and volunteers engaged with Nethra on topics ranging from leadership to gender inclusivity. It was a celebration not just of achievements, but also of the resilience, journeys, and aspirations that women bring to the world of work.




Field Team Trainings: Empowering through Knowledge and Skills

Menstrual Hygiene Sessions



To ensure our Class Assistants (CAs) are well-prepared to support students, eVidyaloka organized Menstrual Hygiene Awareness sessions for both male and female CAs, conducted in separate batches. Since CAs interact daily with boys and girls in schools, it is vital for them to have the right knowledge and sensitivity about menstruation, enabling them to confidently assist if a girl student needs support during school hours.




The sessions were led by ASHA (Altruism Society Honour Assistance), an Assam-based organization with expertise in this field. Trainers fluent in local languages were assigned to conduct these sessions, each lasting 90 minutes and involving 10 to 15 participants at a time. This initiative plays a critical role in building a safe and supportive environment for all students.




Spoken English Sessions






In response to feedback from partners and Field Coordinators (FCs), eVidyaloka introduced Spoken English Training for the field team. Communication with Volunteer Teachers (VTs) and participation in group discussions often involve English, creating a barrier for many CAs. Lack of English proficiency can also limit their professional growth and confidence.







The training is being conducted by Orbit Skilling Solution, a specialist in communication upskilling. Each CA is participating in 20 interactive sessions, with batch sizes of 20 to 25 participants. Through this program, we aim to equip our field team with practical English-speaking skills, empowering them to communicate more effectively and expand their professional horizons.

Workshops for Class Assistants in Assam, Uttar Pradesh, and Karnataka



Personal Development Workshops

To strengthen the personal and professional growth of Class Assistants supporting the EmpowerED program, eVidyaloka hosted a two-day online Personal Development Workshop from 21st to 22nd March 2025.



Facilitated by Vinay Patil, founder and CEO of Skillfix, the sessions were held in Hindi for participants from Uttar Pradesh and Assam, and in Kannada for those from Karnataka. The workshop saw the enthusiastic participation of 40 Class Assistants and 3 Field Coordinators, along with their respective state leads.

The goal of the workshop was to help Class Assistants cultivate essential life skills, develop leadership abilities, and build a growth mindset. The sessions combined practical strategies with reflective storytelling to create a meaningful learning experience.

Day One focused on five core principles of life—honesty, generosity, truthfulness, passion, and compassion—illustrated through relatable school-based scenarios. The session on self-esteem used the analogy of a chessboard to explain how each person's journey is unique, encouraging participants to focus on their own paths instead of comparing themselves with others. Attitude was another major theme, highlighting how a shift in perspective can turn challenges into opportunities. Leadership was redefined as an internal quality—one that begins with taking initiative and setting examples, rather than holding a title.

Day Two introduced 21st-century skills such as critical thinking, adaptability, innovation, communication, and time management. Participants were taught how to prioritize tasks using the Eisenhower Matrix. A particularly moving moment was the story of Harekala Hajabba, a humble fruit seller who built a school in his community through sheer determination and teamwork.









The impact of the workshop was deeply felt. Class Assistants reported increased confidence in managing time, setting goals, and building stronger relationships with stakeholders such as Volunteer Teachers, Headmasters, and parents. They left with a renewed sense of purpose and readiness to apply these learnings in their daily interactions.

Al Workshops for Class Assistants



eVidyaloka conducted a three-day online Artificial Intelligence (AI) workshop for Class Assistants supporting the EmpowerED program to introduce foundational concepts of AI, along with practical exposure to tools that can support digital learning environments.

The sessions were conducted in Hindi for Class Assistants from Uttar Pradesh and Assam, and in Kannada for those from Karnataka. A total of 40 Class Assistants and 3 Field Coordinators participated, with sessions facilitated by Pratik Rajurkar in Uttar Pradesh and Assam, and Suhas in Karnataka.





Class Assistants explored how AI is shaping learning across the world, from creating personalized experiences to supporting teachers with planning and evaluation. The sessions also touched upon critical ethical aspects of AI, including data privacy, algorithmic bias, and responsible usage, encouraging participants to approach the technology with awareness and discernment.

The second day focused on developing a core skill in today's AI-powered world-prompt writing. Class Assistants learned how to structure effective prompts for AI tools, enhancing the relevance and accuracy of generated responses. Using real-life examples from classroom situations, they experimented with crafting prompts that could help with content creation, student engagement, and administrative tasks.

On the final day, the CAs were introduced to a range of AI tools that support lesson planning, worksheet generation, interactive content creation, and time-saving automations. Through live demonstrations and collaborative discussions, participants mapped out ways in which these tools could enhance their contribution to the digital classrooms.



The impact of the workshop was immediate and meaningful. Class Assistants shared that they felt more confident and curious about AI, and were eager to apply their learnings in their respective schools. One participant mentioned that learning about AI had opened up a new world of possibilities for assisting students, while another expressed how prompt writing would now be a regular part of their preparation. The sessions also sparked a sense of innovation, as participants began to envision how small changes in their workflow, aided by AI, could lead to greater efficiency and engagement in the classroom.

As eVidyaloka continues to strengthen the EmpowerED program, such initiatives ensure that Class Assistants remain not only effective in their current roles, but also prepared for the future of education.
