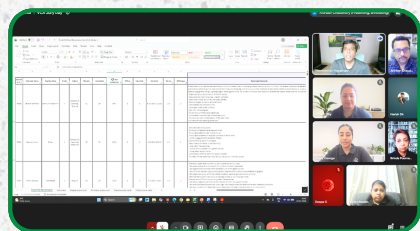
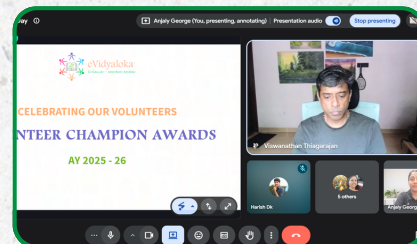


Volunteer Champion Awards Jury Round

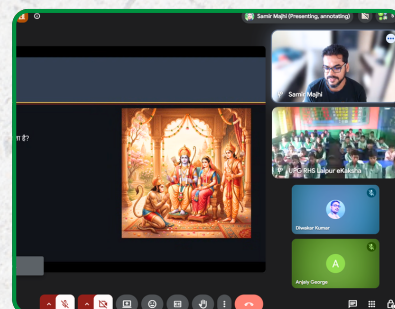

Joy of Connect with Google

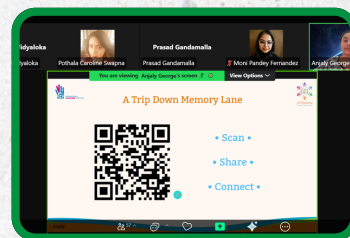
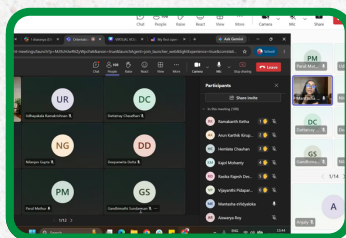
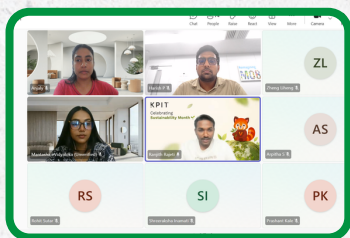
