A special thanks to our on-ground partner, HCT, for their unwavering support in making this initiative a reality.

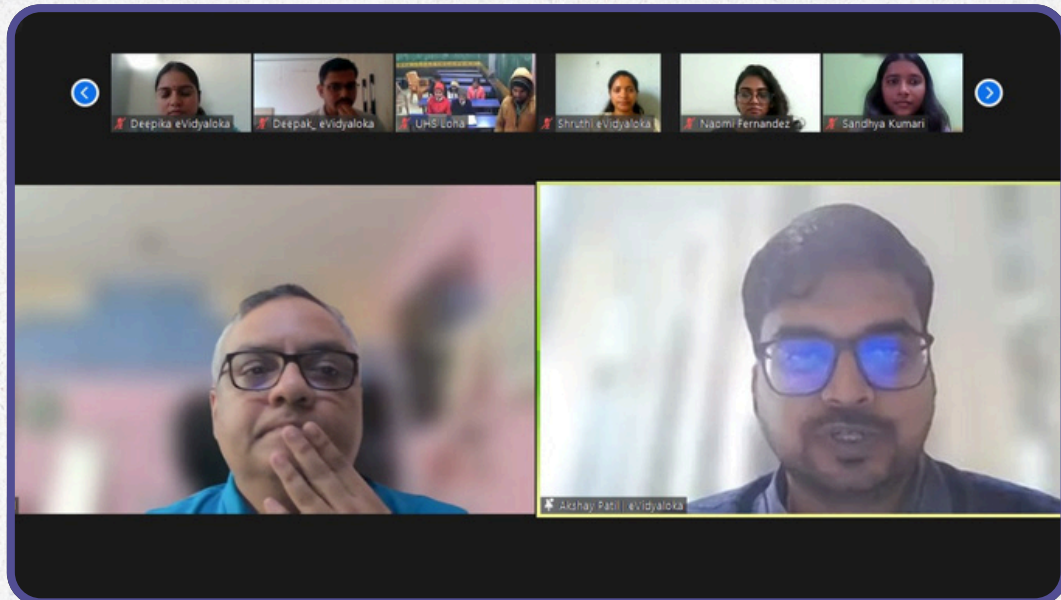
This collaboration is just the beginning. By combining expertise, resources, and vision, we aim to bridge educational gaps and empower students in government schools with digital learning opportunities.





Mathematics for Everyone: A Celebration of Numbers

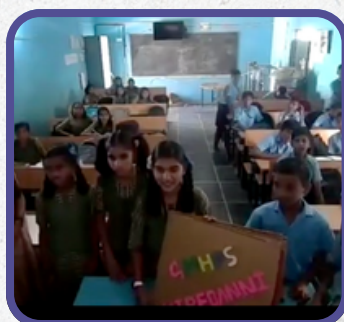

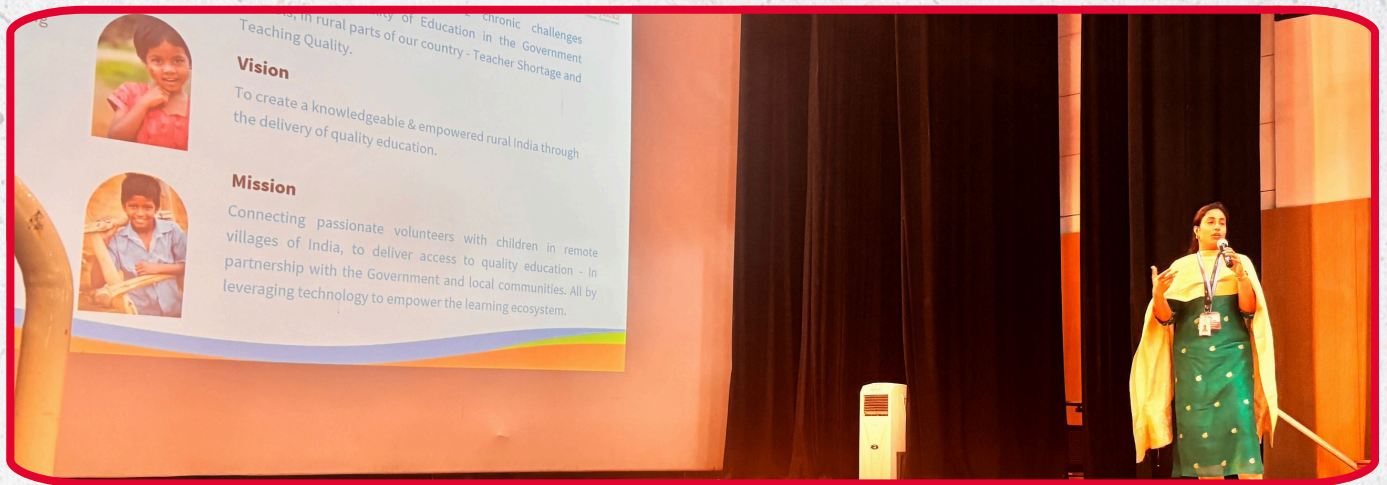


From social awareness to environmental sustainability, these projects reflected the incredible potential of our young changemakers.

The meet ended on a high note, with volunteers pledging to bring more educators into the movement and strengthen our reach in rural schools.



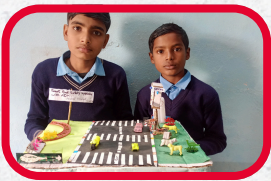
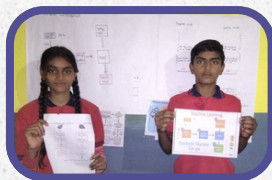
BRAINIAC 2025: The Finalists Announced

As part of the **Build Rural Artificial Intelligence Network (BRAIN)** initiative, BRAINIAC 2025 was launched to empower students in rural schools to **explore AI and develop real-world solutions** by applying the AI knowledge and concepts learnt.



BRAINIAC received over **1,000 submissions** from **400 schools** across **10 states**. 400 projects advanced to the quarterfinals. The top 77 projects made it to the semifinals.

After a rigorous evaluation by **Microsoft's Jury Panel**, 10 finalists are selected from **77 submitted projects**. The top innovations demonstrated **creativity, AI knowledge, resource optimization, scalability, and real-world impact**.



The finalists will now compete in the **Grand Finale on February 21, 2025, at Chancery Pavilion, Bengaluru**, where they will present their projects for the final evaluation.

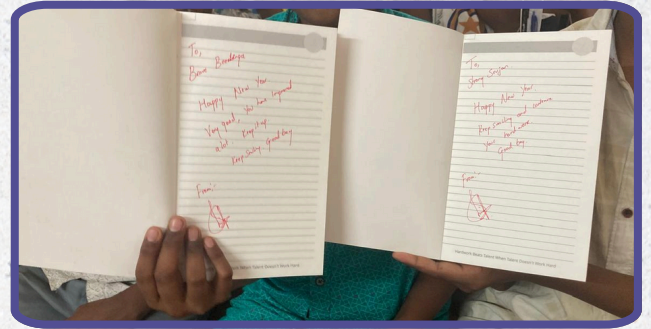

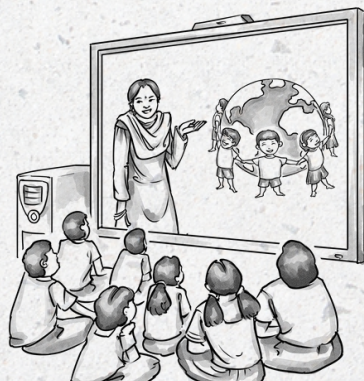
