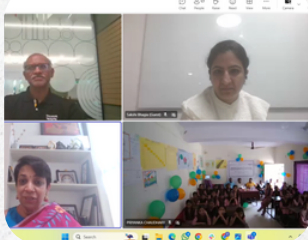


Microsoft-EmpowerED: Bridging the Digital Divide in Rural Education

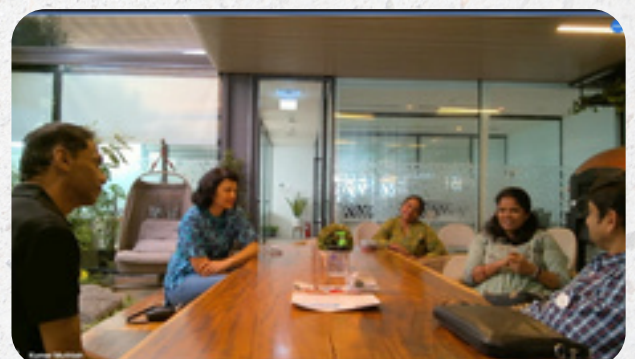

Dubai Chapter Meet: A Celebration of Connection and Commitment

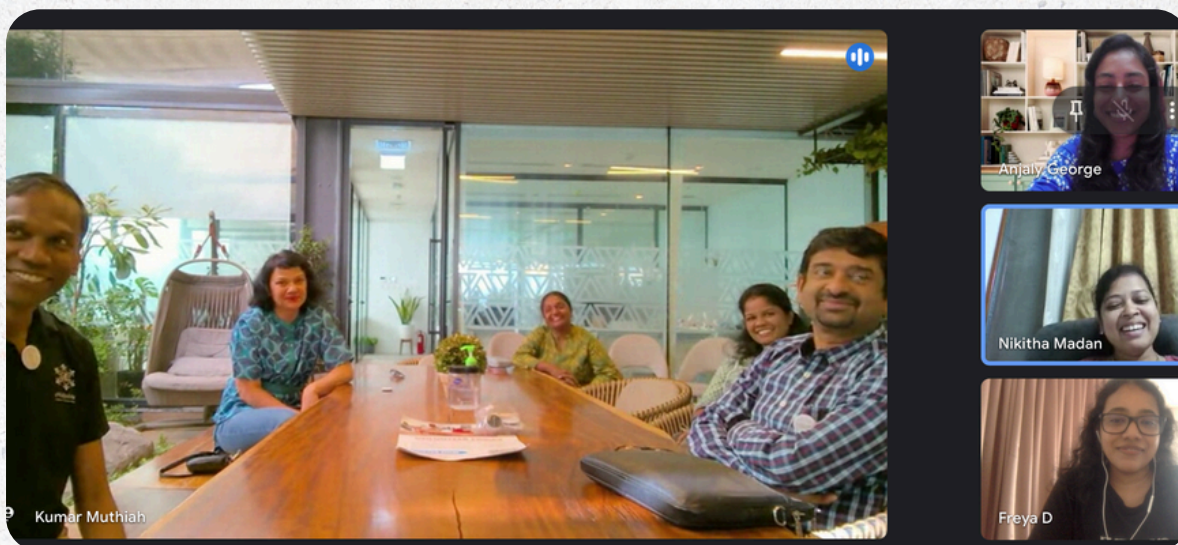
