Building Confidence Through Spoken English

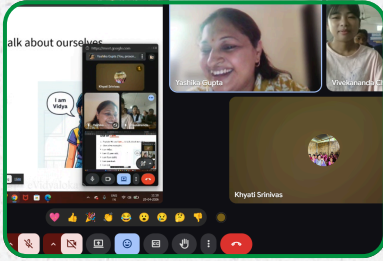

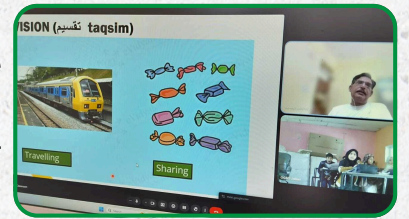
Expanding Horizons: Pilot Launch in Arunachal Pradesh



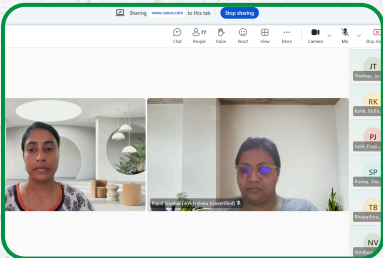

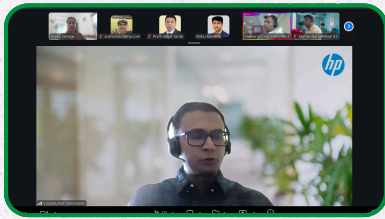
Celebrating Academic Excellence in Jharkhand

From Distraction to Determination: Sakthivel's Journey Back to Learning



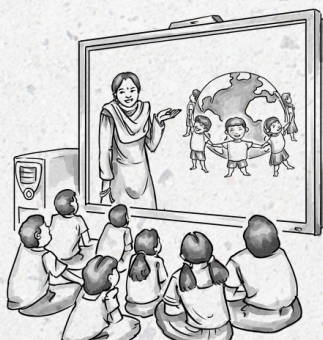
